Punctuality & Academic Regularity

Offline Learning

- Kindly ensure that your ward joins school on the notified reopening date and follows the prescribed winter and summer timings punctually.
- Regular revision at home and timely submission of assignments and projects are essential for steady academic progress.

Online Learning

- The school provides a comprehensive e-learning platform with videos, assignments, and question banks. Parents are requested to ensure its regular use.
- Students must observe punctuality, discipline, and proper etiquette during online sessions, as the school follows an integrated offline–online learning approach.

Communication & Collaboration

- Parents are requested to check the school diary daily, read teacher remarks carefully, and countersign them.
- Please mention your ward's name, admission number, class, and section in all communications.
- Inform the school promptly of any change in address, contact number, or personal details.
- Regularly access the school portal/app, facebook, instagram twitter for updates, circulars, and communication.
- Parents may meet the Principal, Coordinators, or Teachers during notified visiting hours; prior appointments are appreciated.

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Responsibility & Participation

- Attendance in all Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) is essential for monitoring the child's growth.
- Kindly encourage your ward to participate wholeheartedly in academic, sports, cultural, and co-curricular activities.
- Do not send valuables or expensive items to school; the school cannot assume responsibility for loss.
- Label all belongings clearly with the child's name, class, section, and admission number.

Safety & Security

- Parents are requested to personally drop and receive children, especially up to Class V, and strictly adhere to school timings.
- During school hours, students will be handed over only to authorized persons recorded in the school diary, in genuine emergencies.
- Kindly ensure safe and verified transport arrangements with proper driver identification.
- Students should carry all required materials in the morning; items cannot be delivered during school hours except in exceptional cases through the main gate.

Consideration & School Etiquette

- Do not send your ward to school if suffering from any infectious illness.
- Avoid planning appointments or social engagements during school hours.
- Parents are requested not to enter classrooms or disturb the learning environment.
- Provide limited pocket money (maximum ₹50 if required for canteen).
- Kindly consult the school calendar and circulars before making telephonic inquiries.
- Please refrain from criticizing the school or teachers in the child's presence; constructive concerns may be discussed with school authorities.
- For birthdays, only one pencil per child may be sent; sweets and gifts are not permitted. Children up to Class V may come in casual dress.
- Kindly send only vegetarian food in the lunchbox.

Eco-Friendly Commitment

- Jimp Pioneer School is a proud polybag-free campus. Parents are requested to avoid sending any items in plastic or polythene bags and support our eco-friendly mission.
