



## SCHOOL RULES



1. Every student must bring the school diary and identity card to school every day.
2. Students must paste their photograph and fill in the required parent details in the school diary.
3. Students who come on their own must reach school before the bell.
4. School gates will be closed on time, and latecomers may face action.
5. Morning assembly is compulsory for all students and teachers. After the bell, everyone must go to the assembly area quietly and in a line.
6. Students are not allowed to miss any teaching, games, or library period.
7. While changing classrooms between periods, students must move quietly and in an orderly manner.
8. Jimp Pioneer School students should always be polite and courteous. They should behave well with everyone in and outside the school and avoid bad language or behaviour.
9. Students must take care of school property. They must not damage furniture, write on walls, or spoil others' belongings. Any damage, even by mistake, must be reported to the class teacher. Sharp objects are not allowed in school.
10. Lending or borrowing money or other items among students is not permitted.
11. Students must not bring books other than textbooks or library books, magazines, or any other materials to school without the principal's permission.
12. Juniors should show respect to their seniors.
13. Students are not allowed to bring mobile phones to school. Strict action will be taken if they do. Staff members should not use mobile phones in class and must keep them on silent during school hours.
14. Students are not allowed to make or receive phone calls during school hours, except in emergencies through the school office.
15. Students who come with escorts must not leave before their escort arrives. In case of delay, they should report to the school office.
16. Students who go home on their own should go straight home and not loiter on the way. They should not buy anything from roadside vendors.

17. Students should not accept Favors, gifts, food, or rides from strangers. They should always say “No” if something feels wrong or unsafe.
18. Students must help keep the school clean and green. They should not throw waste like cups or paper on the school premises.
19. The use of polythene bags is strictly prohibited. Students should bring jute or cloth bags. For projects or files, handmade paper should be used.
20. Students should feel proud of their school and sing the National Anthem with respect and sincerity.
21. Students must wear neat and proper school uniform every day.
22. Personal hygiene and cleanliness are very important.
23. Students should reach school regularly. Attendance is compulsory, and leave must be taken with a proper application from parents.
24. Students must complete their homework and classwork on time and submit assignments as instructed.
25. Respect for teachers and staff is compulsory.
26. Students should greet teachers politely and follow instructions sincerely.
27. Discipline must be maintained in classrooms, corridors, playground, buses, and during all school activities.
28. Bullying, teasing, or hurting others physically or verbally is strictly prohibited. Kindness and teamwork are always encouraged.
29. Students must participate actively in academic and co-curricular activities for overall development.
30. During practical classes, labs, and sports, students must follow safety rules carefully.
31. School resources such as smart boards, computers, library books, and lab equipment must be used responsibly.
32. Honesty is expected at all times. Cheating in exams or copying homework is not allowed.
33. Students should maintain silence in the library and respect the learning environment.
34. Eating junk food inside classrooms is not permitted. Students should bring healthy and nutritious food.
35. Good manners, positive attitude, and helpful behaviour should be shown at all times.
36. Students must follow environmental values and save water and electricity.
37. Every student should represent the school with pride, dignity, and good character both inside and outside the campus.
